PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

We have officially completed a full month of virtual teaching. Visiting classrooms and viewing student participation has been insightful. Student engagement, voice and small group interaction ensures student engagement. Staff are using whiteboards, google slides, jam boards screencastify etc. These enhance lessons but create interactive lessons for our students.

Opportunities to talk to peers was offered last week: 20 mins for Junior and Primary. Students were able to talk about anything from pets/animals, holidays, sports - list was endless. They were placed into breakout rooms based on interest and I would jump into meetings. I observed students just enjoying company and talking about their topics and sharing screens as well. Definitely served the purpose of sharing ideas but also addressed the wellbeing component.
