Replenishing previously spent funds into their respective funding pots $(\$ 3,886.54)$ ( $\$ 121.54$ overhead, $\$ 1000$ classroom supplies, $\$ 1435$ scientist in the school, $\$ 800$ leaving ceremony 2023, \$30 lice treatment, \$500 Raz Kids) - amounts could be increased in funds available if 2022/2023 requests from staff change from previous year TBD - passed
Set aside \$650 for upfront costs for Meet the Teacher BBQ - based on estimate from end of the year BBQ of previous council - passed
Purchase branded "thank you cards" at cost of \$30-passed

I don't have to amend the funds promised/available after the amendment to our thank you card purchase because the remaining will stay in the funding pot for overhead.
