## **Elect new Secretary and Treasurer helper**

Erin is closing out the year as Treasurer, but has a conflict for Tuesday meetings. Looking to elect a helper that can learn from Erin and possibly prepare to transition to become Treasurer for the next year.

Amy reminds the council that without a Treasurer we cannot have a Parent Council.

Paisley could possibly fill the role as a last resort, but is stretched thin and does not want to take up the role except as a last resort.

Marc has agreed to take on the Secretary role for the rest of the year (Thank you!), but will be moving on from BCPS after this year. We will need to consider who can take on this role in the next school year.

## Principal's Report - Sadhana Lad

BCPS students and staff ended the year on a great note. We saw students participate in Luv to Groove and this was accompanied with our first ever presentation for parents. We also welcomed parents to celebrate and share a story with classes where students had a snack while enjoying a story. Finally, our choir led by Mr. Richmond performed at our monthly assembly where students shared their achievements. We look forward to hosting events where families can take part in their child's learning and successes.

It is great to see the students return back to school! At this point in the year, students are familiar with routines and ready to resume achieving their learning goals. We have continued with our daily announcements with a focus on character goals. Situations



and scenarios are given to students on daily announcements where students are encouraged to use the strategies in the situations that may arise throughout their day. Our spirit days with a cause continues with Black Excellence Day, which will take place on the 19th and Bells Let's Talk Day is taking place on Jan.25th

Our educators are currently working on assessment and evaluation. The January 20th PD will be a day for report card writing and Principals and Vice Principals will also develop their professional learning and development focused on identifying and addressing antisemitism.

There are some items to be requested by the school that would benefit from some support from Parent Council finances. This will be brought forward later in the meeting.

## **Teacher Report - Marianne Tilton**

- After the 2 week break, educators are now busy preparing report cards -- collecting data, collaborating with each other, etc. Educators will reach out to parents about progress or concerns as reports approach.
- Support schedules for reading groups and math are being updated as students needs change and as we received quite a few new students to the school in December / January. Our early literacy interventions are starting to show that they are helping students improve reading skills.
- Educators are grateful for the ongoing support of council.

## **Questions for Principal/Teacher**

Destinee asks about field trips and whether there are upcoming events for the students.

Sadhana responds: there are some field trips that are in motion and some that have occurred, but there is a serious challenge with scheduling buses for travel. Due to shortages of drivers and limited bus availability, the school is limited for field trip activities.

Elysa expands on the above and adds that certain activities are also struggling with available resources. She gives the example of trying to schedule "Swim to Survive", but running into limited time slots due to the City having limited life guards available for such activities. As such, there aren't any slots at a time that makes sense for BCPS to book.

- The McMillians fundraiser amount has not been deposited as I haven't received it yet, so it is not included in this month's report - I believe the amount was \$847.95
- Updated projected amount to be raised from fall pizza days will be approx \$1200
- \$30 outstanding cheque for BCPS for notecards is ready for the school
- \$2,034.00 for Luv2Groove has been paid to school
- \$1,091.76 was provided to staff for classroom supplies to date, leaving \$408.24 available in the allotted funds if any additional staff wishes to submit receipts
- \$2,300.00 remains allotted for Scientist in School/Virtual Ventures, but there is room to increase the amount
- \$200.00 is also allotted for lice treatment in case that's needed
