Walk a Block Initiative



Transportation

IMPORTANT: The office does not have up to date information when bus or van routes are canceled or delayed or running again. Families are encouraged to check the <u>OSTA Website</u> regularly for any cancellations or delays. We recommend that you <u>subscribe to their alerts</u> by going to the bottom of their main page, to receive notifications straight to your email.

Picking up your Student at end of day

If your student's pick up arrangements change at the end of day, you need to notify the office no later than <u>2:30 p.m</u>. This allows the office and educators to prepare the student(s) for pick up and this also ensures safety of traffic at the end of the day. Especially bus students who are not taking the bus, this needs to be clear <u>before 2:30 p.m.</u> You can also email <u>bcpsattendance@ocdsb.ca</u> to let us know <u>before 2:30pm</u> that your student's pick up arrangements have changed.

Signing Students in and out outside of arrival and dismissal times

If you are picking up/dropping off your student outside of the usual arrival and dismissal times, you must ring the bell to notify the office you are here and who you are picking up. As with last year's procedure, families will wait outside for their students to come out. For drop off, the office will unlock the door and only the student will come in. For kindergarten students, a staff member will be there to greet the child. Please try to avoid student pick up during recess times during 11:15am to 11:40am or 2pm to 2:25pm. It makes it difficult to locate your child on the yard and this avoids unnecessary wait times.

Reporting Your Student's Absence



In order to ensure the safety of our students it is <u>IMPORTANT</u> that families continue to notify the school when their child is absent. This also applies to days when the buses are canceled or the weather is extremely bad. <u>We should be notified of all student absences</u>. Please email us at bcpsattendance@ocdsb.ca. and leave a detailed message with your child's name and teacher and nature of absence.
