Ontario's Crossing Guard Laws Affect YOU...

Drivers must STOP

Where there is a Crossing Guard displaying a Stop Sign, all drivers (including cyclists) must STOP and yield to the pedestrians.

Drivers must WAIT

Drivers must wait until all pedestrians (including the Crossing Guard) have cleared the ENTIRE crosswalk before proceeding through it.
